Dear Member/Guest **International i-Power Conference 2015**

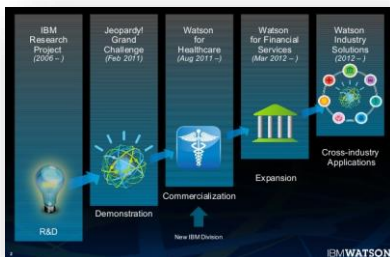
Here we are again, ready to start the International i-Power Conference for 2015 at the Wyboston Lakes Conference Center in Bedfordshire and, yet again, we have a great, two-day event to bring to you.

This year, we have increased the number of educational sessions with some exceptional topics covering SQL Awesomeness, IBM POWER Performance Management – *for free*, using the Row & Column Access Control (RCAC) as well as how to run Open Source software right on your IBM i.



This year we have a special user guest – the NSPCC! Yes, an organization that relies on its POWER platform running IBM i just as much as you do. The day is opened by Alison Butterill, no stranger to the UK IBM scene and a strong supporter of our i-UG group. Alison, now the World Wide Manager for the IBM i offering will help position IBM and POWER and set the tone for the Conference. Alison will also deliver a session on the future of POWER a little later.

As always, the Sponsors have stepped up to the plate and will stand up and be counted. We will run the very popular Sponsor Speed-dating at the beginning of the Conference and if you have not seen this before, I can tell you that it is as entertaining as it is informative.
